§ 113.01 FRANCHISE REQUIRED TO OPERATE CABLE TELEVISION SYSTEM.

It is required that any individual, corporation, or other entity desiring to operate any cable television system or any facilities therefor within the boundaries of the town, first obtain a franchise to do so from the Board of Commissioners. The franchisee shall be upon reasonable terms consistent with the rules and regulations of the Federal Communications Commission. ('85 Code, § 17-1.1) (Ord. 39, passed - -) Penalty, see § 113.99

§ 113.99 PENALTY.

(A) *Criminal.* In accordance with § 10.99(A) of this code of ordinances, any person who violates any provision of this chapter shall be subject to a fine not to exceed \$100 per offense.

(B) *Civil.* In accordance with § 10.99(B) of this code of ordinances, any person who violates any provision of this chapter shall be subject to a civil fine of \$100 per offense. ('85 Code, § 17-1.2) (Ord. 39, passed - - ; Am. Ord. 93-11, passed 9-7-93)
