



**STATE OF EMERGENCY  
AMENDMENT NO. 3**

**WHEREAS**, On March 23, 2020, under Article 1A of Chapter 166A of the North Carolina General Statutes and Chapter 33 of the Town of Holden Beach Code of Ordinances, the Town of Holden Beach declared a State of Emergency based on the public health emergency posed by COVID-19; and

**WHEREAS**, the State of Emergency was amended to include restrictions on March 23, 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, the restrictions, under section "Discontinuance of Short-Term Rentals" of the State of Emergency was amended on March 27, 2020.

**NOW THEREFORE** the said State of Emergency, with subsequent amendments, be modified to include:

Discontinuance of Short-Term Rentals – All rental agencies and property owners who rent properties within the Town of Holden Beach are instructed to have all short-term renters, defined as persons who rent for a period of less than three months' duration, and their invitees, vacate the premises and leave the Town of Holden Beach no later than 2:00 p.m. on March 28, 2020. Effective thereafter, there shall be no short-term rental occupancies within the Town of Holden Beach until at least **April 29, 2020**.

This amendment is effective Tuesday, March 31, 2020 and shall remain in force until rescinded or amended. All other restrictions currently in place shall remain in force until rescinded or amended.
