

**TOWN OF HOLDEN BEACH  
ORDINANCE 08-03**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 51: WATER AND CHAPTER 52:  
WASTEWATER OF THE HOLDEN BEACH CODE OF ORDINANCES**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY** the Mayor and Board of Commissioners of the Town of Holden Beach, North Carolina, that Chapter 51: Water and Chapter 52: Wastewater be amended as follows:

**Section One:** Amend Section 51.10 (A) to read as follows:

- (A) Meters will be read and bills rendered *monthly*, but the Town reserves the right to vary the dates or length of period covered, temporarily or permanently, if necessary or desirable.

**Section Two:** Amend Section 51.10(D) to read as follows:

- (D) Readings from different meters *including meters that may be for the same or different premises, for the same or different consumer and for the same or different services, may be billed on the same invoice.*

**Section Three:** Amend Section 51.10(E)(1)(b) to read as follows:

- (b) *That if any delinquent bill is not paid by the due date of the following bill, service will be disconnected for non-payment on or about the sixth day after the due date. The preceding bill containing the past due balance from the prior month will serve as the second notice.*

**Section Four:** Add Section 51.10(G) as follows:

- (G) Payments will be due on the last day of the month. If the last day of the month falls on a weekend, payment will be due the following Monday. Payments received after the due date will be charged a late fee of ten percent of the total bill.

**Section Five:** Add Section 52.09 as follows:


§ 52.09 METER READING; BILLING; COLLECTING; SUSPENSION OF SERVICE;  
COMPLAINTS; ADJUSTMENTS

- (A) Meter reading, billing and collecting of funds for wastewater shall be in accordance with the regulations set forth for water in §51.10
- (B) Suspension of service shall be in accordance with the regulations set forth for water in §51.11.
- (C) Complaints and adjustments shall be in accordance with the regulations set forth for water in §51.12.

**Section Six:** The Town Clerk is directed to forward this ordinance to American Legal Publishing for inclusion in the next published supplement to the Holden Beach Code of Ordinances.

**Section Seven:** This ordinance shall be effective the 22<sup>nd</sup> of April, 2008.
