Resolution Granting Permission to Hold the Bark at the Beach Fundraiser to Benefit Easter Seals and to Utilize the Holden Beach Pavilion for the Fundraiser

WHEREAS, Easter Seals has been helping individuals with disabilities and special needs and their families live better lives for more than 80 years; and

WHEREAS, Easter Seals provides a variety of services to help people with disabilities address life’s challenges and achieve personal goals, from child development centers to physical rehabilitation and job training; and

WHEREAS, Volunteers have organized an activity “Bark at the Beach Dog Walk” with the intent to raise funds for Easter Seals; and

WHEREAS, all proceeds of the 3rd Annual “Bark at the Beach Dog Walk” would benefit Eastern Carolina Easter Seals; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Holden Beach has a Pavilion Use Policy that restricts reserved use of the Jordan Boulevard Pavilion to Town sponsored events; and

WHEREAS, The Town of Holden Beach has supported and sponsored the “Bark at the Beach” for two previous years.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Holden Beach North Carolina do hereby grant permission for the Bark at the Beach fundraiser to be held at Holden Beach and for the Holden Beach Pavilion to be utilized during the event.
