

RESOLUTION 09-10
RESOLUTION OF BOARD OF COMMISSIONER OF HOLDEN BEACH,
NORTH CAROLINA, ADOPTING THE TOWN'S CAMA CORE LAND USE
PLAN

WHEREAS, the Town's CAMA Core Land Use Plan was financed in part through a grant provided by the North Carolina Coastal Management Program through funds provided by the Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972, as amended, which is administered by the Office of Ocean and Coastal Resource Management, National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration; and

WHEREAS, the Town drafted a Land Use Plan with the assistance of its consultant, Cape Fear Council of Governments, and conducted a series of public workshops and meetings as part of a comprehensive public participation program under the leadership of the CAMA Land Use Plan Committee; and

WHEREAS, the CAMA Land Use Plan Committee recommended adoption of the draft CAMA Core Land Use Plan; and

WHEREAS, at a duly advertised Public Meeting on the 11th day of May, 2009, the Board held a public hearing on the draft CAMA Core Land Use Plan; and

WHEREAS, at the Public Meeting on the 11th day of May, 2009, the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Holden Beach, North Carolina found the policies in the draft CAMA Core Land Use Plan to be internally consistent; and

WHEREAS, at the Public Meeting on the 11th day of May, 2009 the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Holden Beach, North Carolina found the policies and Future Land Use Map in the draft CAMA Core Land Use Plan to be consistent with the Town's desired vision for the future and unanimously approved to adopt the draft CAMA Core Land Use Plan as amended; and

WHEREAS, the adopted Plan will be submitted as required by state law to the Wilmington District Planner for the Division of Coastal Management under the North Carolina Department of Environmental and Natural Resources and forwarded to the Coastal Resources Commission; and

WHEREAS, a review of the adopted Plan by the Coastal Resources Advisory Council (CRAC) of the Coastal Resources Commission will be scheduled; and

WHEREAS, the CRAC will decide on a recommendation to the Coastal Resource Commission (CRC) at the meeting; and

WHEREAS, the CRAC chairman will submit the recommendation to the CRC and the CRC will then vote on certification of the Town's Land Use Plan; and

WHEREAS, a certified Holden Beach CAMA Core Land Use Plan will be forwarded to the Office of Ocean and Coastal Resource Management (OCRM) for federal approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Holden Beach, North Carolina, has unanimously adopted the draft CAMA Core Land Use Plan; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Town Manager of the Town of Holden Beach is hereby authorized to submit the adopted CAMA Core Land Use Plan to the State for certification as described above.
